### **MAI- MATHEMATICAL ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW 2021**

This interview is an opportunity for teachers to get to know your child and their mathematical understanding. The interview will take approximately 30 minutes to complete.

- Friday 29th January Kindergarten children only

Please note that all interviews will be held in the 2021 classrooms and bookings can be made with any of the teachers in your child's stage.

If your child is unable to be tested at a suitable time for you with their stage teacher Mrs Maria Famularo, Mrs Karen Buccini or the Assistant Principal Mrs Annemarie Bond will be available for interview bookings during the times.

Any child who is not assessed at one of these opportunities will be assessed as soon as possible in the first weeks of school.





### ADDED CONTROLS:

Coach will stop game as part of the learning process and give RULE REMINDERS.

All hazards e.g goal posts are padded or removed.

Each team is given a high school leader as their on-field PLAYER/COACH to help enforce rules.
