## END OF YEAR REPORTS - UPDATE

This semester, our school is one of a number of Diocesan schools that is transitioning to a new CEDP reporting system through an application called COMPASS. This system when completed will allow parents to be able to go online and access school reports and attendance at any point throughout the school year.

As we begin to transition to this reporting system you will notice that this semester we are continuing to report student achievement in the same subject areas using the E-A grading as always, as well as providing information about effort and application. There will be a general comment and a section for work habits.

The whole grade comparisons of subject achievement will no longer be included on the report though can be requested once you receive the school report, if you so wish.

Next year we will be moving away from the E-A scale to a word based 5 point scale which will better reflect the achievements of each child in the respective curriculum areas.

Reports will be sent home Monday of Week 9 and as always the class teachers are available for further clarification or discussion if required. This report format will be used by all grades, Kindergarten to Year 6.

### MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT INTERVIEWS

At the beginning of the 2021 school year the teachers at St Monica's will again be administering the Mathematical Assessment Interview (MAI) for each of the students in their stages.

This is a 1:1 interview with a student and takes approximately 30 minutes. The information gathered from this assessment will assist the teacher's knowledge of where the students are in their understanding of number.

In week 10, families will receive a login code via Skoolbag to use with the school interview online booking tool to organise an appointment time.

The MAI interviews will take place on:

- Wednesday 27th January
- Thursday 28th January
- Friday 29th January Kindergarten children only



Please note that all interviews will be held in the 2021 classrooms and bookings can be made with any of the teachers in your child's stage.

If your child is unable to be tested at a suitable time for you with their stage teacher Mrs Maria Famularo, Mrs Karen Buccini or the Assistant Principal will be available for interview bookings during the times.

Any child who is not assessed at one of these opportunities will be assessed as soon as possible in the first weeks of school.

How can I purchase a Device?

Chromebooks

The Catholic Education Office has a purchasing portal for Chromebooks which includes the Google Management Console (Licence) and is fully set up for our school's network at **approx \$396**. There you will be prompted to enter first name, last name, email address and a password. To order and gain access to the portal you must use the Activation code ceobyod

Order your device by 4th December to receive free shipping to our School. All you have to do is change the delivery address to our School and all Chromebooks will arrive before the end of term.

ALL 2021 Team Sport Trials are OPEN, however, the Summer Sports of **BASKETBALL & TENNIS** registrations close for these sports only on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November as these trials are planned for November & December 2020. This will be confirmed closer to the date due to COVID-19 restrictions and venue availability.

All other sports trials will be held in Term One & Two in 2021.

Under no circumstances will a child be eligible to trial if the **2021 CEDP Primary Sport TEAM Registration** Form has not been completed and approved by the school by the closing date.
