

APPLE MUFFINS

Easy / 0:10 Prep / 0:20 Cook / Makes 12

Ingredients

- 13/4 cups self-raising flour sifted
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup milk
- 2 eggs
- 50 g butter melted
- 200 g canned pie apple
- 2 tbs cinnamon sugar





Method

- 1. Mix milk, eggs and butter together.
- 2. In a separate bowl, combine flour, sugar and apple.
- 3. Add milk, egg and butter mixture. Stir until mixture is well combined.
- 4. Pour mixture into greased muffin pans.
- 5. Dust tops with cinnamon sugar.
- 6. Bake at 200C for about 20 minutes.


